The Millimeter Miracle

"For by wise counsel thou shalt make thy war: and in multitude of counsellers there is safety." -- Proverbs 24:6

On Saturday, July 13, a 20 year old man fired several rounds at former President Donald Trump. One of the bullets hit him, clipping his right ear. Providentially, Trump had just turned his head to look at the screen behind him. Had he not done so, the bullet would have hit him squarely on his head, most likely killing him instantly.



This is being called, "The Millimeter Miracle."

On Sunday, the day after the assassination attempt, the former and possibly future president posted on Truth Social.

"Thank you to everyone for your thoughts and prayers yesterday, as it was God alone who prevented the unthinkable from happening. We will FEAR NOT, but instead remain resilient in our Faith and Defiant in the face of Wickedness. Our love goes out to the other victims and their families. We pray for the recovery of those who were wounded, and hold in our hearts the memory of the citizen who was so horribly killed. In this moment, it is more important than ever that we stand United, and show our True Character as Americans, remaining Strong and Determined, and not allowing Evil to Win. I truly love our Country, and love you all, and look forward to speaking to our Great Nation this week from Wisconsin."

The former president shared the "very surreal experience" that nearly ended his life during an interview aboard his private plane enroute to the Republican National Convention in Milwaukee, "The doctor at the hospital said he never saw anything like this, he called it a miracle." He also said, "I am supposed to be dead" and then repeated, "I am supposed to be dead."

No, Mr. President, you are supposed to be alive! God planned it so.

The Word of God reminds us in **Acts 17:28** *"For in him we live, and move, and have our being..."* God has a purpose for sparing your life.

During an interview

Monday on NBC's "TODAY" show, Trump campaign senior adviser, Jason Miller, said the former president "feels very fortunate" to be alive.

"And as he said, it's only by the grace of God that he's even still with us. It's miraculous that President Trump turned his head just that slight amount at the right moment to avoid the bullet," Miller said. "And the message that President Trump is coming out with after this is very simple: We have to unite America. We have to unite the country."

Asked by host Savannah Guthrie on the "TODAY" show if he expects a different tone from Trump going forward, Miller pointed to Trump's <u>post</u> on his social media site Truth Social on Sunday urging the need to be "resilient in our faith and defiant in the face of wickedness." He added, "The disunity and the unrest that's happening at the national level just simply isn't good for the country. It cannot persist. We have to come together in this moment."

President Joe Biden called on Americans to "lower the temperature" of political rhetoric in an address from the Oval Office on Sunday night, asking for more respectful discourse and civility in the wake of the

"Disagreement is inevitable in American democracy," Biden said, "but politics should never devolve into a 'killing field.""

"While we may disagree, we are not enemies," Biden said in remarks that lasted about six minutes. "We're neighbors, we're friends, co-workers, citizens, and most importantly, we are fellow Americans. We must stand together."

The Republican National Convention was held in Milwaukee, Wisconsin last week. They nominated Donald Trump as their candidate for the presidency and J.D. Vance as his running mate. Vance is a prodigy, an intelligent and young VP nominee who, <u>according to</u> political pundit Ben Shapiro, is an audacious pick as opposed to a politically strategic one.



Vance, a 39-year-old Marine veteran and Yale Law graduate from workingclass Appalachia, is the first millennial to run on a major party ticket. Author of

Severe storms and several tornadoes ravaged New York State last week, leaving a trail of destruction and killing at least one person, with hundreds of thousands of energy connections lost to downed power lines.

Governor Kathy Hochul declared a state of emergency across the state Tuesday. She said central New York, Mohawk Valley and the Southern Tier had been hardest hit. She spoke with both the mayor of Rome, Jeffrey Lanigan, and Oneida County Executive Anthony J. Picente Jr. Lanigan said at a news conference: "It looks like a war zone." Rome suffered the most damage, since a tornado roared straight down the main street of the city.
